- Description of how attendees may benefit from your presentation
- Original work of the presenter
- Speaker’s topic expertise and knowledge
- Speaker’s presentation experience and skill level

Submit the following information in your Presentation Proposal:

- Title of Presentation
- Speaker/Presenter Information (Required)
 - * Speaker Information: Name, Agency/Organization, Title, Brief Bio, and Email
- Presentation Abstract (approximately 60 words, for publication in conference marketing materials)
- Presentation description: 200-300 words
- Conference track (See page one)

Presenter Selection

After careful evaluation, proposals will be selected and scheduled for presentation based on appropriateness and applicability of the topic. Selection of presenters will be announced via e-mail on or before October 1, 2019. Selected presenters must confirm their commitment to present by October 15, 2019. Corresponding papers and/or presentations may be published by the ILETSEI following the 2020 conference.
